

RIVERINA INTERCLUB CHALLENGE

MAJOR PRIZE DRAW ELIGIBILITY

Criteria:

- A Junior or Senior rider who enters and competes in all rounds of any of the available disciplines as per the Riverina Interclub Challenge calendar for the current year will receive 2 tickets to go into the major prize draw.
- A Junior or Senior rider who enters and competes in all but one round of any of the available disciplines as per the Riverina Interclub Challenge calendar for the current year will receive 1 ticket to go into the major prize draw.
- A Junior or Senior rider who misses 2 rounds or more in any of the available disciplines is not eligible for the major prize draw.
- Proof that the rider has entered and ridden in each of the rounds will be confirmed from sign on sheets, lap score sheets & transponder database.
- In the event that a rider in the Leaping Log Enduro Series chooses not to compete and is deemed to be an official worker at one of the Enduro rounds will satisfy the eligibility guidelines for the major prize draw as if they had entered and competed.
- The major prize will be drawn at the Riverina Interclub Challenge presentation night at the end of the year. Eligible riders will be presented with their tickets on the night and must place their own tickets in the barrel to be included in the draw.
- Riders must be present in person at the draw to be eligible to win the major prize draw, a re-draw will take place if the first name drawn out is not present in person.
- An eligible rider list will be displayed on the Riverina Interclub website at the end of the last round for the year before the draw takes place.
- Riverina Interclub Challenge committee members and their families are allowed to be included in the draw as long as the eligibility criteria is met.
- Riders choosing not to use a transponder who ride the required amount of rounds will be included in the draw as long as the eligibility guidelines are met.
- The Riverina Interclub Challenge Committee and associated sponsors or Host Clubs of this Series' accepts no responsibility for entries not placed in the Draw for any reason, and reserves the right to disqualify entries that do not comply with these Terms.
